- **CALL TO ORDER**
Mayor Coleman called the meeting to order and determined a quorum.
Present were Kevin Painter, Scottie Betts, Vanessa Presson and Sam Gilley.
- **OPENING CEREMONIES**
 - A. Invocation was given by Sam Gilley.
 - B. Pledge of Allegiance was led by Kevin Painter.
 - C. Mayor Coleman welcomed everyone in attendance.
- **APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM REGULAR SCHEDULED MEETING May 2, 2022**
Alderman Presson made motion to approve minutes of May 2, 2022 as written.
Alderman Betts seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.
- **APPROVAL OF AGENDA for June 6, 2022**
Alderman Betts made motion to approve agenda of June 6, 2022. Alderwoman Presson seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.
- **REPORTS**
 - A. Parks and Recreation / Public Works-
Mike Hutcherson on park activities and maintenance. He noted all-star practices are now going on. Mayor Coleman reviewed with the board of his decision to reduce the splashpad hours to 10 am- 2 pm for next couple of weeks to help the county residents with their water pressure. JEA will be connecting a pipe to the

splashpad and installing a meter for water usage until the water issue with Gibson County has been resolved. Alderwoman Presson asked about an update on the water issue with Gibson County Water. Mike stated they were going to have to relay pipes with larger pipes and it will take them 2-3 years to complete project. Their first priority is to supply water to the existing new construction on Blackmon.

B. Fire Chief-

Jeff Rollins reported 23 runs for May, 18 city and 5 county. He also reviewed the monthly statistics.

C. Police Chief- Jason Oliver absent

D. Building Inspector- Matt Brown absent

E. Recorder/Treasurer-

Kim Gilley noted that the city has secured July 4th date to have the fireworks show.

- Sales Agreement – Golconda LP and the City of Medina
Alderman Betts made motion to approve the sale agreement between Golconda LP and the City of Medina. Alderman Painter seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.
- Construction of Fire Station approval/ Architect Agreement
Alderman Painter made the motion to approve the architect agreement for the construction of the fire station. Alderwoman Presson seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.

Alderman Painter made motion to approve second reading of ordinance adopting annual budget for FY 2022 -2023 year and set tax rate. Alderwoman Presson seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.




