- **CALL TO ORDER**

Mayor Coleman called the meeting to order and determined a quorum.

Present were Alderman Kevin Painter, Alderman Scottie Betts, Alderwoman Presson, and Alderman Sam Gilley.

- **OPENING CEREMONIES**

A. Invocation was given by Sam Gilley.

B. Pledge of Allegiance was led by Vanessa Presson.

C. Mayor Coleman welcomed everyone in attendance.

- **APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM REGULAR SCHEDULED MEETING on June 6, 2022**

Alderman Betts made motion to approve minutes of June 6, 2022 as written.

Alderman Gilley seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.

- **APPROVAL OF AGENDA for July 11, 2022**

Alderman Kevin Painter made motion to approve agenda of July 11, 2022.

Alderwoman Presson seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.

- **REPORTS**

A. Parks and Recreation / Public Works- Mike Hutcherson absent

B. Fire Chief- Jeff Rollins absent

Jim Simpson reported 10 calls for the month of June being 4 city and 6 county.

C. Police Chief- Jason Oliver absent

Lt. Mathenia reported 424 calls for service, 122 traffic violations, 1015 camera citations, and 9 arrest for the month of June.

D. Building Inspector- Matt Brown reported 4 building permits, 4 plumbing permits, and demolition permit issued for the month of June.

E. Recorder/Treasurer-

Kim Gilley reported that P/R truck and P/W truck was not received in prior budget but bid was received and PO issued therefore it will be credited to 21-22 budget when payment made. Police body cams and car cameras have not been purchased, no PO or public bid notice therefore they will have to be re-evaluated this new budget year. Auditors begin first week of August.

- **CITIZENS INPUT**

No comments or concerns. Ms. Debra Burkart thanked the city for the July 4<sup>th</sup> firework display.

- **Multimodal Application**

TDOT has notified City of Medina that we have been accepted to re-apply for sidewalks on east side of Main Street from Foster to Church and then down Church to the apartments- split over 3 fiscal years. The match would be 10% (\$116,000). Does the city want to re-apply for grant?

City of Medina received notification of \$77,865 that is available to be applied to the Downtown Enhancement Grant. Written justification of cost estimate is being prepared to submit for the money.

Alderman Painter made motion to approve the submission of application for the Multimodal with the City's match being \$116,000 split over three years. Alderman Sam Gilley seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.


