- **CALL TO ORDER**

Mayor Coleman called the meeting to order and determined a quorum.

- **OPENING CEREMONIES**

- **APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM REGULAR SCHEDULED MEETING on July 11, 2022**

Alderman Betts made motion to approve July 11, 2022 minutes as written.

- **APPROVAL OF AGENDA for August 1, 2022**

Alderman Painter made motion to approve August 1, 2022 agenda. Alderwoman Presson seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.
  
- **REPORTS**
  - A. Parks and Recreation / Public Works-

Jason Oliver reported 473 calls of service, 80 citations for 93 violations, and 984 camera tickets for July. He submitted quote for car and body cams with equipment needed. Quotes totaled \$107,584.75. Alderman Scottie Betts made motion to put this equipment out to bid. Alderman Painter seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.


