- **APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM REGULAR SCHEDULED MEETING on August 1, 2022**

Alderman Betts made motion to approve minutes as written. Alderman Gilley seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.
  
- **APPROVAL OF AGENDA for September 12, 2022**

Alderman Gilley made motion to approve agenda for September 12, 2022. Alderman Betts seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.
  
- **Fire Station Design Review Approval**

Car Cameras/Body Cameras Bid

Mayor reviewed the camera cost being \$96,265.00 with additional cost for installation. The total cost is \$115,888.75. Alderman Gilley made motion to approve purchase of car and body cameras from Insight with installation from Area Wide and computer set from SOS for the amount of \$115,888.75 to be paid for out of Camera Fund. Alderman Betts seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.

Matt Brown reported 10 permits and 11 citations issued for the month of August.

• **CITIZENS INPUT**

Mary Varner spoke about noise complaints. Loud music and lights until 2:00 am- it was noted the city would send letter to 106 Main as a warning. It was noted that a strong smell was also coming from the premises.

• **Waste Management Addendum Discussion**

Alderman Betts made motion to approve addendum with the inclusion of \$12.50 per month fee and maximum of 1 additional cart. Alderman Painter seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.


